Why Support Staff Wellness?

- Wellness refers to the holistic and multidimensional process of being healthy and finding balance in the many aspects of our lives.
- Staff wellness shapes their engagement with children and families, job satisfaction, and overall quality of life.
- Babies and toddlers need consistent, warm, and responsive caregivers who provide nurturing interactions.

What Can I Do As a Program Leader?

- Prioritize a culture of wellness within the program.
- Explore strategies to promote staff wellness.
- Reflect with program staff on ways to cultivate a culture of wellness within the workplace.

Culture of Wellness

This is a working environment where an employee's overall wellness is valued, supported, and promoted through worksite wellness programs, policies, benefits, and environmental supports.



How Do I Prioritize and Plan for Staff Wellness?

- There are many ways to support staff wellness.
- For example, you can reflect on aspects of wellness and plan for program improvements and change.



Plan for Staff Wellness



Identify ways to prioritize staff wellness.



Invite staff to offer ideas for how to better support their wellness.



Develop and implement a wellness plan based on staff input.



Evaluate the program wellness plan often, and include staff in this process.

Physical				Relieve caregivers' physical strain by including adult- sized furniture and steps to help toddlers reach diaper- changing tables.
Social				Support social networks within your program, such as wellness, social, and celebration committees.
Environmental				Improve and enhance workspaces, which may include a comfortable and inviting staff break area.
Emotional				Promote and support wellness and mental health breaks.
Intellectual				Create a book-sharing library or book clubs.
Occupational				Support and encourage individualized plans for career advancement and professional development.
Spiritual				Encourage individual and group opportunities to expand a sense of purpose, balance, and peace.
Financial				Provide materials and resources that connect staff to financial planning and other related community supports.
