About QRIS

A quality rating and improvement system (QRIS) is a systemic approach to assess, improve, and communicate the level of quality in early and school-age care and education programs. Similar to rating systems for restaurants and hotels, QRIS award quality ratings to early and school-age care and education programs that meet a set of defined program standards. By participating in their State's QRIS, early and school-age care and education providers embark on a path of continuous quality improvement. Even providers that have met the standards of the lowest QRIS levels have achieved levels of quality that are beyond the minimum requirements to operate. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has a High Priority Performance Goal to increase the number of States and Territories with strong quality rating and improvement systems.

QRIS are composed of five common elements:

- 1. Program Standards:** QRIS standards are built on the foundation of child care licensing requirements and add multiple steps between licensing and higher quality standards, such as those associated with accreditation.
- 2. Supports for Programs and Practitioners:** Support for providers, such as training, mentoring, and technical assistance, are included to promote participation and help programs achieve higher levels of quality.
- 3. Financial Incentives:** Financial incentives, such as quality bonuses and tiered subsidy reimbursement (which pays a higher reimbursement rate to providers who care for children from families who receive CCDF subsidies and meet standards beyond minimum licensing), are awarded to programs when quality levels are achieved.
- 4. Quality Assurance and Monitoring:** Accountability and monitoring processes are used to track progress toward, attainment of, and maintenance of program quality standards.
- 5. Consumer Education:** Most QRIS award easily recognizable symbols, such as stars, to programs to indicate the levels of quality and inform and educate parents.

Web Sites for QRIS Quality Standards

QRIS quality standards are used to assign ratings to programs that participate in QRIS, providing parents and the public with information about each program's quality. States typically use licensing standards as the starting point, or base, of the system, on which higher levels of quality standards are built. Every QRIS contains two or more levels of standards beyond licensing, with incremental progressions to the highest level of quality as defined by the State. Systems vary in the number of levels and number of standards identified in each level. The types of standards used by QRIS to assign ratings are based on research about the characteristics of programs that produce positive child outcomes.

The following tables provide the Web sites for States' QRIS standards compiled by the National Center on Child Care Quality Improvement (NCCCQI). States often have multiple sets of standards for specific types of early care and education providers, such as child care centers, family child care (FCC) homes, and school-age programs.

States Implementing QRIS

The table below includes 36 States that are implementing a statewide QRIS model. For some States, it is noted if the QRIS is being revised, operating only in limited areas of the State, or is available only for specific types of providers (e.g. providers receiving public funding).
