Building the Supply of Care

- ◆ Providing certificates/vouchers
 - Tribally operated center closures
- ◆ Contracts or grants
- ◆ Supporting the providers through mini-grants
- ◆ Recruiting family child care providers
- ◆ Recruiting in-home provider
- ◆ Recruiting relative providers
- ◆ Payment practices
 - Paying based on enrollment versus on attendance
- ◆ Supporting provider with start-up cost
