Note: Tribes with medium and large allocations are required to establish payment rates for child care services that ensure eligible families have equal access to child care services comparable to those services provided to families not eligible to receive CCDF services. Tribal Lead Agencies may set differential payment rates for providers in order to build the supply of high-quality providers or providers serving underserved populations. For example, Tribal Lead Agencies could choose to set differential rates for: Provider type, age, children with special needs, geographic location, providers offering care during nontraditional hours, providers who have enhanced quality ratings, or providers who incorporate Indigenous language and culture into their program. This worksheet is an option tool that Tribal Lead Agencies may use when setting their rates. There is no federal requirement around the format of rate setting.
