

Tribal CCDF Plan

What is the Tribal CCDF Plan?



- ◆ The Tribal Lead Agency's application for CCDF funds:
 - Describes the Tribal Lead Agency's child care program and services available to eligible families
 - Contains specific assurances and certifications required by CCDBG Act of 2014 and accompanying rule
 - Provides information about the overall management of CCDF services

Tribal Allocation Sizes

(Based on the FY 2016 CCDF Tribal Allocations)

Establishes 3 tiers of Tribal Lead Agencies based on the size of their allocation using the FY 2016 CCDF Allocation Table

Small Allocation Tribes

(Under \$250,000)

S

Must spend their funds in alignment with CCDF Goals and Purposes

Exempt from the majority of CCDF requirements (must meet quality and health and safety requirements)

Option to submit an abbreviated CCDF Plan

Medium Allocation Tribes

(\$250,000 - \$1 million)

M

Allowed the same exemptions as the Large allocation category

Exempt from operating a certificate program

Large Allocation Tribes

(Over \$1 million)

L


Subject to the majority of CCDF requirements




Tribal CCDF Plan Final Approval Letters

Final Approval Letters

- ◆ The letter also lists the provisions requiring corrective action
 - In some cases, Tribal Lead Agencies rely on partnerships with states for some requirements and *states* will need to take corrective actions for Tribal CCDF Plans to be in compliance no later than 9/30/2022

****Note: These are the 221 non-477 Tribal grantees***




FY 2020-2022 Tribal CCDF Plan Structure

Final Approval of Unmet Need



- ◆ Each Section of the Plan that has been identified as needing to be amended has been addressed
- ◆ Plan amendments have been completed and approved by the Office of Child Care
- ◆ Final approval letters have been issued.






Monitoring of Conditions

Ongoing Monitoring of CCDF Program

- ◆ The CCDF Plan includes questions that encompass all elements as required by regulations at 45 CFR 98.81
- ◆ However, the Plan does not ask about all aspects of Federal requirements
- ◆ Recognizing that the information in the Plans is not exhaustive, OCC will monitor Tribes' ability to meet the requirements through multiple mechanisms



Mechanisms of Monitoring Conditions

- ◆ Approval of Plan Amendments
- ◆ ACF-696T
- ◆ ACF-700 Narrative
- ◆ 102-477 Reporting Process

Amendment Process

Submitting Plan Amendments

- ❑ Discuss with OCC Regional Office where to amend the Plan
- ❑ Make changes to the Tribal CCDF Plan fillable PDF where applicable
- ❑ Save as “FY2020-2022 Tribal CCDF Plan [Tribal Name] Amendment 1.pdf” in order to document the specific changes made.
- ❑ Send an email to OCC Regional Office*
 - Body of email:
 - Section amended
 - Proposed effective date
 - *Up to 60 days prior to submitting amendment*
- ❑ Attach amended Tribal CCDF Plan as a complete file
